4. Motion by Howell to adopt Vernon County Multi-Hazards Mitigation Plan 2023-2028, seconded by Grisham.
5. Buchanan Property Counteroffer-motion to approve made by Howell, seconded by Nash. Roll call, all in favor. Motion carried.
6. Motion by Howell to approve Notice of Disallowance of Claims regarding J. Weber. Seconded by Grisham. This would be sent to Weber before 120 days of receipt of his claims.
